Lauer Farms 1944  
Rules & Regulations

1. All participants must be pre-registered. NO WALK ONS.
2. Basic safety and authenticity checks will take place at sign in. (i.e. haircut and other basics).
  - a. Bring all ammo for inspection at sign in.
  - b. Class 3 firearm owners will need to show the firearm and tax stamp to LEO.
  - c. Vehicles will be given a safety inspection at sign in.
  - d. Please have emergency contact info available.
3. You will receive a registration card at sign in. KEEP these on your person at all times during the event.
4. Safety and authenticity standards will be held and inspected every morning by unit CO and a S&A officer from Lauer Farms 1944.
  - a. USGI MP's and Feldgendarmerie will be conducting random spot checks on registration cards and ammo throughout the day.
5. Safety briefs will be held each morning and before each skirmish (along with ammo check).
  - a. Each unit within the Allied and Axis camps will be assigned a Battle Group Letter. (i.e. Allied Group A, Axis Group B). Your group is located on the registration card presented to you. Each battle will be assigned different groups.
  - b. Battle groups for each daily battle will be announced at the safety meeting each morning.
  - c. The only thing set in stone is the "winner" in the morning meeting. It will be decided who wins the morning battle, the side that wins the morning will lose the afternoon one.
  - d. Safety officers will be on the field. Their word is law.
  - e. **AMBULANCE** is the word for getting an EMT to the situation. If you hear the safety word, call a ceasefire immediately.
6. NO pyrotechnic devices or grenades are permitted.
7. Rifle grenades and mortar rounds will be inspected by Lauer Farms 1944 staff
8. Absolutely NO political impressions. (i.e. German SA or other similar units).
  - a. You will be removed from the property, and permission revoked for future events if you show up with a banned impression.

9. NO propaganda, political banners, or flags to be displayed or flown.
  - a. If seen you will be banned from future events and escorted off the property immediately.
  
10. NO NSDAP (National Socialist German Workers Party) arm bands permitted.
  - a. The following are permitted:
    - i. Medic
    - ii. Free French
    - iii. Red Cross
    - iv. HJ/ BDM
    - v. DRK
    - vi. Others may be permitted but will have to be cleared by Lauer Farms 1944 staff.
  
11. NO loaded firearms in the camp area.
  - a. If you need to function check your firearm, please go to the approved area (BATTLEFIELD) and yell "fire in the hole."
  - b. When you reach the battlefield this is the appropriate time to lock and load.
  
12. IN CAMP SPEED LIMIT - 5 MPH
  
13. If moving armor or other large vehicles, use a spotter.
  
14. All tents and shelters must be period appropriate.
  
15. NO alcohol or drugs permitted on park property.
  
16. NO hand to hand combat type actions during skirmishes.
  - a. MEDICS MUST ASK PERMISSION TO TOUCH BEFORE PERFORMING DUTIES.
  
17. NO war crimes during skirmishes.
  
18. Your camp must be kept neat and tidy. Please hide all modern items out of sight.
